Bed linen get change once a week or when the guests ask for it. Towels are not included in the linen, but they can be washed.

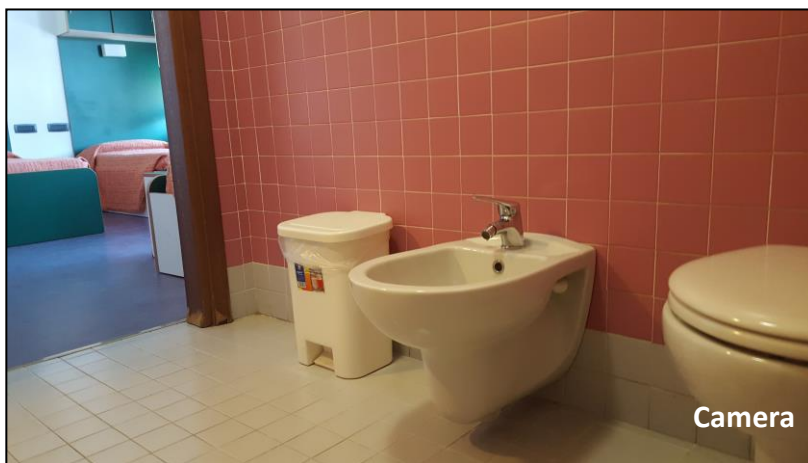
