

WP4: «Governance and definition of urban and national energy strategies»

Definition of a technical Draft of strategic energy plan. Through continuous contact with the Palestinian Energy Authority it can be extended at national level

General obj. «to increasing the capacity of Palestine's renewable energy autonomy»

Establishment of a unit within the Municipality of Bethlehem (called "Renewable Energies" – ER) able to correctly manage the various aspects related to the promotion of the rational use of energy and the diffusion of renewable sources

Specific obj. «To improve the governance of the renewable energy supply chain»

To improve strategic aspects that characterize the local coordination and promotion of the territory
