QUICK FACTS ABOUT STS

- Funded in 1967
- Taught about 30.000 students in and around Bethlehem
- the School offers courses on Turning, Electricity, Auto Mechanics, Autotronics, Electronics and Carpentry
- New curriculum in renewable energy will start in August 2018

STS is part of the Middle East Salesian Province. Within the NUR project, the School will host the trainings at its Vocational Training Centre (VTC). The teachers of STS will also receive a ToT, becoming themselves trainers/tutors for the next trainings.

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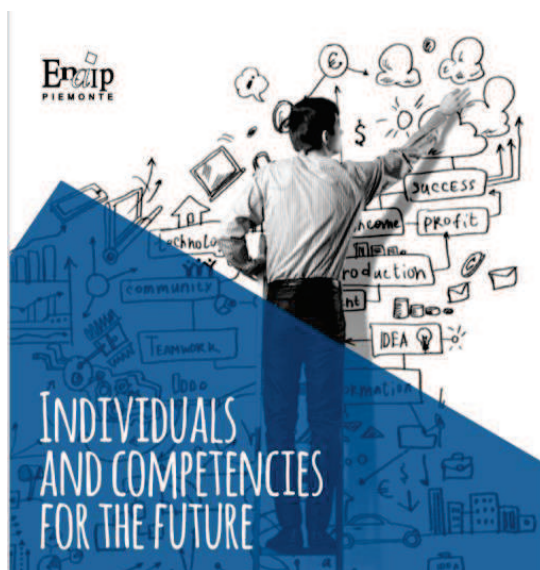

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ACTIVITY 2.2: Preparation of formative materials

Partner involved	Content	Timeline
En.A.I.P. with the support of VIS	Once the educational program has been defined, training materials will be produced and printed, all in English	By August (the first training will start in August)

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ACTIVITY 2.3: Training Courses

Partner involved	Content	Timeline
En.A.I.P. and VIS, with the support of STS	5 courses on the topics of renewable energies and management and administration of small enterprises	The ToT will take place during the first year, while the remaining ones will be carried out during the second year.

- Dissemination activities are foreseen in order to spread out the educational programme
- The courses will take place at STS and the teachers of the school will be involved in the ToT, becoming themselves tutors for the trainings of Palestinian young people and entrepreneurs during the second year, according to a cascade logic
- Beneficiaries: 40 Palestinian youths, 20 entrepreneurs, 20 teachers

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ACTIVITY 2.4: Support to the creation of business

Partner involved	Content	Timeline
Bethlehem University + VIS + En.A.I.P.	1-selection of 4 young people who will produced a business plan for start-up 2-the 4 start-up will be incubated by the BBI for one year	Selection of 4 students at the end of the second year, incubation throughout the third year

- The Bethlehem University, through the BBI, will make services available for each start-up for about 20.000 Euro/each. One part-time resource will be dedicated to this activities.
- The 4 students will be selected by an expert identified by En.A.I.P. with the support of VIS and STS.
- The installed panel systems will be used by the students to collect data, necessary for the development of the business plans.

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SUMMARY

- The WP2 will be implemented thanks to the collaboration of four different partners: VIS, En.A.I.P., BU and STS
- All the processes will be developed through a participative approach, taking into consideration the point of view of all the partners involved
- The implementation of WP2 will start during the first years with the definition of the educative program and the production of training materials, will continue with the carry out of the trainings during the second year and will end up with the incubation of 4 start up during third year.
