THE CITY OF SALT LAKE CITY – UTAH (U.S.A.)**

**The City of Salt Lake City – Utah (U.S.A.)** – represented by the City Mayor, Ross. C. ANDERSON and **the City of Torino – Italy** – represented by the City Mayor, Sergio CHIAMPARINO, both acquainted with their mutual capacity to sign the present twinning act,

CONSIDER THAT

1. The aims the twinned cities include in their programs provide for the promotion of peace through mutual respect, comprehension and cooperation,
2. The cities play a key role in the economic, cultural and social development,
3. The City of Salt Lake City and the City of Torino share a common experience having both faced the important challenge represented by the Winter Olympic Games and their aim is a positive and long-lasting inheritance of the event for their citizens, for future generations and for the community in its whole,
4. The main aim for both Cities is to promote the quality of life for their citizens, also encouraging the exchange of experiences with other world realities,
5. The two Cities foster mutual knowledge and exchange of experiences in the economic, cultural, social fields and, generally speaking, in the urban policies one,
6. The two Cities positively accept exchange projects involving the citizens of both municipalities,

Both Cities hence commit themselves to establish friendship and mutual cooperation and declare themselves linked by the present twinning agreement.
