

A protocol
for establishment of sister city relations between
the City of Turin (the Republic of Italy) and
the City of Shenyang (the People's Republic of China)
1985 in Turin

The city of Turin (the Republic of Italy) and the city of Shenyang (the People's Republic of China), both sides have agreed unanimously to establish a sister city relations for further development of the exchanges and cooperations between the two cities as well as the enhancement of the mutual understanding and friendship. On the basis of friendly cooperation as well as equality and mutual benefits, the city of Turin and the city of Shenyang will promote actively economic cooperation and trade relations between the two cities, and will carry out wide exchanges in such fields as science, and technology, culture and education sports and health as well as others, and will contribute to the promotion of prosperity of the two cities and to the development of friendship between the people of the two countries. The protocol will come into force only after the official signature have been obtained from the Mayors of the two cities, and will be written in Chinese, Italian and English being of equal effect.
