#### The network of Strategic Cities

The conference is organized in collaboration with the Network of Strategic Cities (Recs). Recs is an initiative created in 2004 aiming at connecting 27 Italian cities that have adopted a strategic Plan as an innovative tool for the management of local development. The main objectives of the network are the diffusion of an approach to strategic planning as a model of governance, the promotion of comparison between cities, the proposal of shared services for the associated members through forms of cooperation and the creation an international observatory of the cities.

#### **Environment Park**

The conference takes place at Environment Park, a project promoted by the Region of Piedmont, the Province of Torino, the City of Torino and the European Union. It represents an original experience in the panorama of scientific and technological parks by bringing together technological innovation and eco-efficiency. Environment Park hosts more than 50 enterprises and laboratories specialised in these fields. The creation of the Park is also part of a wider project of urban regeneration of the city which gives a new face to a part of Torino. Environment Park is a district of excellence for enterprises of ICT. Among its most relevant activities the supplying of innovative solutions and technologies for small and medium sized enterprises existing in the region and the diffusion of the most representative best practises in the field of ICT and of environmental protection. About ten enterprises operating in the premises of the technological park have been created thanks to the incubator managed by Environnement Park. The Park has more than 30.000 m<sup>2</sup> where are installed laboratories, offices, service centres organized in a unit of buildings distinguished by a low environmental impact (management of the water cycle, water management, utilisation of renewable energetic sources)
