 - a. Definitions

ID	Title	Definition
1	Acceptance of mother tongue	acceptance of the mother tongue of migrants in the dominant society
2	Accompany	relation between the professional and the subject, based on the communication through which the professional makes a follow-up of the evolution of the subject and provides him/her orientation and support.
3	Action	Doing something to change or affect a situation Intervention (in a wide sense). Activity (in a restricted sense)
4	Adolescence	period of biological, psychological and social transition to the adulthood
5	Age of majority	The age at which a person is considered legally adult
6	Assistance	Help or support to a person, group or collectivity
7	Authority	a) a legitimate institution or a person with power or right to take action; or b) a certain power of a person who is accepted by others
8	Bilingual	Using two languages in a normative fashion
9	Citizenship	legal acceptance as a citizen of a state by birth or law Quality of citizen (Inhabitant of a territory with the social and political rights recognised)
10	Civil authority	Civil authority
11	Combat	active opposition
12	Commitment	an obligation that someone sets for himself, of doing something, of accomplishing something
13	Community	inclusive group characterized by common background and norms **
14	Community developments plans	Intentional projects within a community aimed at supporting the improvement of collective situations
15	Community work	Practice of the professionals of the social intervention addressed to the transformation for the improvement of collective situations through associative actions of persons and entities of a territory.
16	Consent	Conscious agreement for which there is accepted an opinion, a demand, an offer or a feeling
17	Consequences of health problems	Personal or collective repercussions of situations of lack of health or non healthy habits
18	Counselling	Help that a professional provides to a subject by means of orientations and advises
19	Creativity	Capacity to find answers and to generate situations in innovative ways
20	Culture	The way of life, expectations and beliefs of a particular group of people
21	Democracy	Government or decision making in that the sovereignty falls on the community.
22	Dialogue of religions	the capacity of communities / groups belonging to different religions to communicate

23	Disability	A specific physical, mental or social situation that affects an individual by limiting his or her ability to perform in any area of human activity below accepted norms.
24	Disagio	A condition of living under par, or in a vulnerable state
25	Disease	Unhealthy condition of the body, physical or mental that impairs normal living.
26	Drug	A substance used by individuals. May be used to change behaviour or mood, combat illness, physical or mental. May have side affects such as creating a dependence or diminishing a person's ability to control their behaviour.
27	Drug Abuse	Use of drugs to a degree that impairs an individual's ability to make rational decisions and to be in control of their physical and mental functioning.
28	early education	education for young minors, usually less than five years ol previous to primary school.
29	Ecology	Study of the interactions between organisms and their environment.
30	Education	A process of systematic instruction, learning and teaching
31	Educational activities	activities involved in the educational process
32	Equipe	Set of educational agents that work coordinatedly
33	Family support	Professional intervention to help a family deal with a specific problem.
34	Free time	Time an individual recognises as not being set aside for work or other regular commitment
35	Gate keeping	we don't know
36	Gender	Situations and problems related to sexual classification
37	Institution	A rather large and permanet organization with roles and patterns of behaviour. The regulations may be official or inofficial, and always carry out f public interest
38	Institutional Relationship	A relationship in an institution or generated through institutional conditions
39	Integration	Process of inclusion in a group or community in which the subject sits member and the other ones recognize them as such
40	Intergenerational	Relation between person from different generations.
41	Involvement	the act of taking part in an event, activity, situation
42	Loco parentis	the legal responsibility of a person or organization to take on some of the functions and responsibilities of a parent
43	Loco parentis arrangement	the situation when a person or organisation acts in loco parentis context concerning a minor
44	Marriage	In strict sense: union legalised of a man and a woman, and in some countries: of two women or of two men. In wide sense: stable union, though it is not legalised.
45	Measure	Educational, organisational, judicial disposition... respect of a person
46	Mental disability	disability in relation psychological or neurological damage.
47	Minor	Someone who has not reached the age of majority
48	Mobile work	Professional intervention that is made in different places?
49	monolingual	Using only one language in a normative fashion
50	Mother toungue	The first language you learnt as a child
51	Multicultural integration	Integration of persons of different cultures becoming part or a unique environment
52	multilingual	Using two or more languages in a normative fashion
53	Parental	Referring to parents by birth, legal order or administrative category
54	Participation	Taking an active role in an activity, in forming policies or plans, in making decisions.
55	Personal development	Process of maturation and learning of the person
56	Prevention	Intervention directed to stop or to reduce the risk that some problematic situation occur
57	Professional	Belonging or related to a profession

58	Reception	A physical location, service or action for access to resources.
59	Reception action	Action of responding, taking in, welcoming, accepting people who seek or are referred to the services.
60	Reception service	The first contact point that either gives access to further services or redirects to other services or places.
61	Reception team	The team of people that performs the initial role of gate keeping to the rest of the services.
62	Remedial	Action taken to counteract the effects of a difficulty or problem.
63	Remedial action	An action or intervention that is remedial.
64	Remedial measure	measure of the action or intervention that is remedial
65	Residential centre	Centre that accommodates in population with problems social, psychological or physical deficits who lives in that centre
66	Sexuality	sexual feelings, attitudes and activities
67	Social Community	Synonym for community
68	Social integration	Process of social integration as a member of a community
69	Social interactions	Reciprocal action or influence between different individuals, or groups of individuals
70	Social Services	the services of a country or city which work in relation to social needs to deal with supporting and managing vulnerable individuals, or groups within the community
71	Socio-educational intervention	Multi-agency approach of educative intervention
72	Socio-labora insertion ??	Socio-educational process which helps people to enter the workplace
73	Substance	A chemical which effects a person if ingested, inhaled or injected.
74	Substance Abuse	the process of overusing a substance (be it a medicine or a drug),
75	Tolerance, not feeling at home	The act or capacity to accept the diversity
76	Transfer of power (empowerment?), Empowerment	An educational process which aims to help people understand their social situation and act positively to improve that situation.
77	Tutelage	Action of the tutor or an institution which has the role of protecting a minor or a person who, for some reason, cannot take care of himself/herself
78	Tutor	Person in charge of the education, guidance, defense or advisement of another person.
79	Violence	An aggressive and harmful act committed against someone.
80	Welcome	Warm, generous or affectionate invitation or gesture
81	Youth	A rather long period between childhood and being an adult

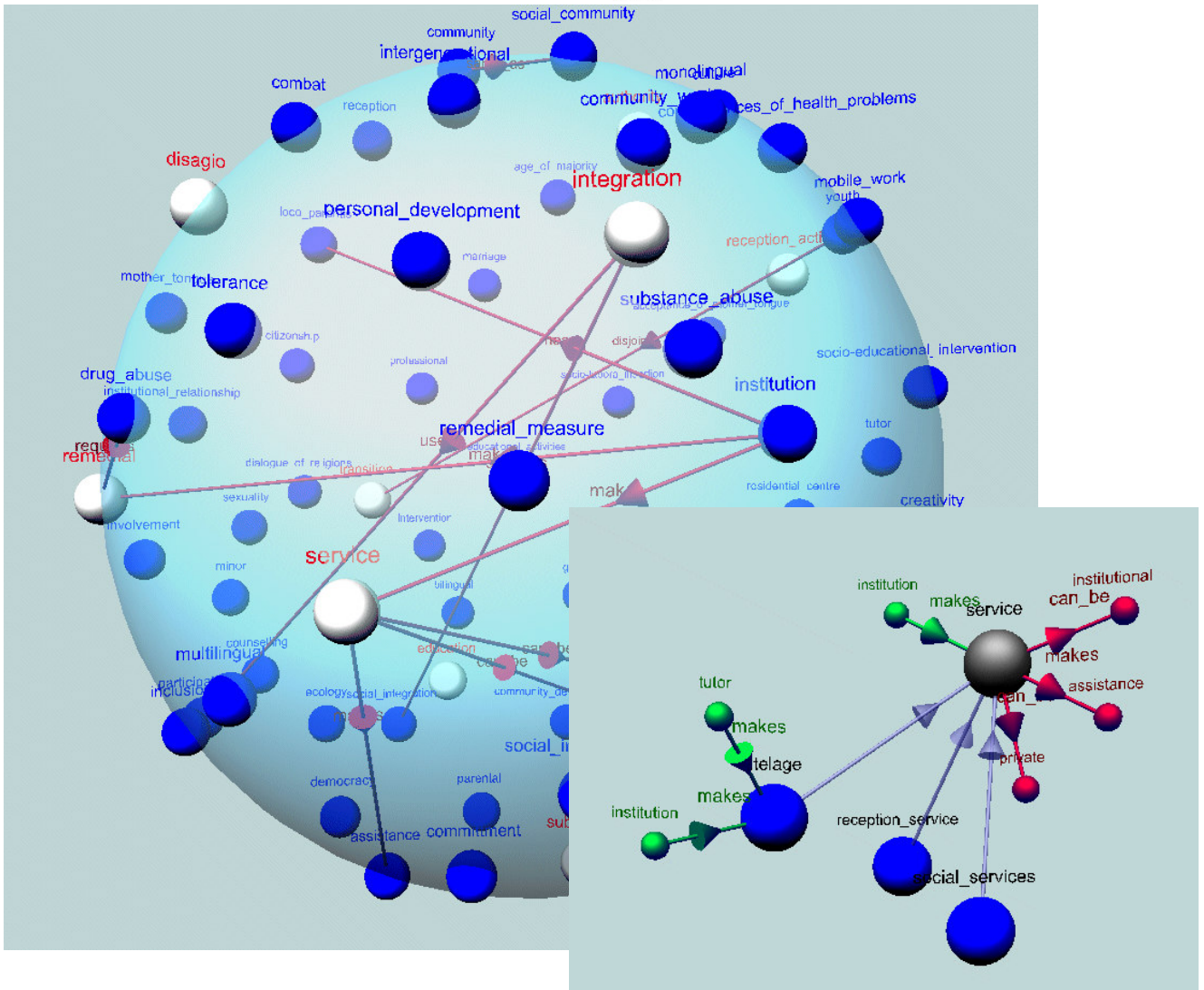
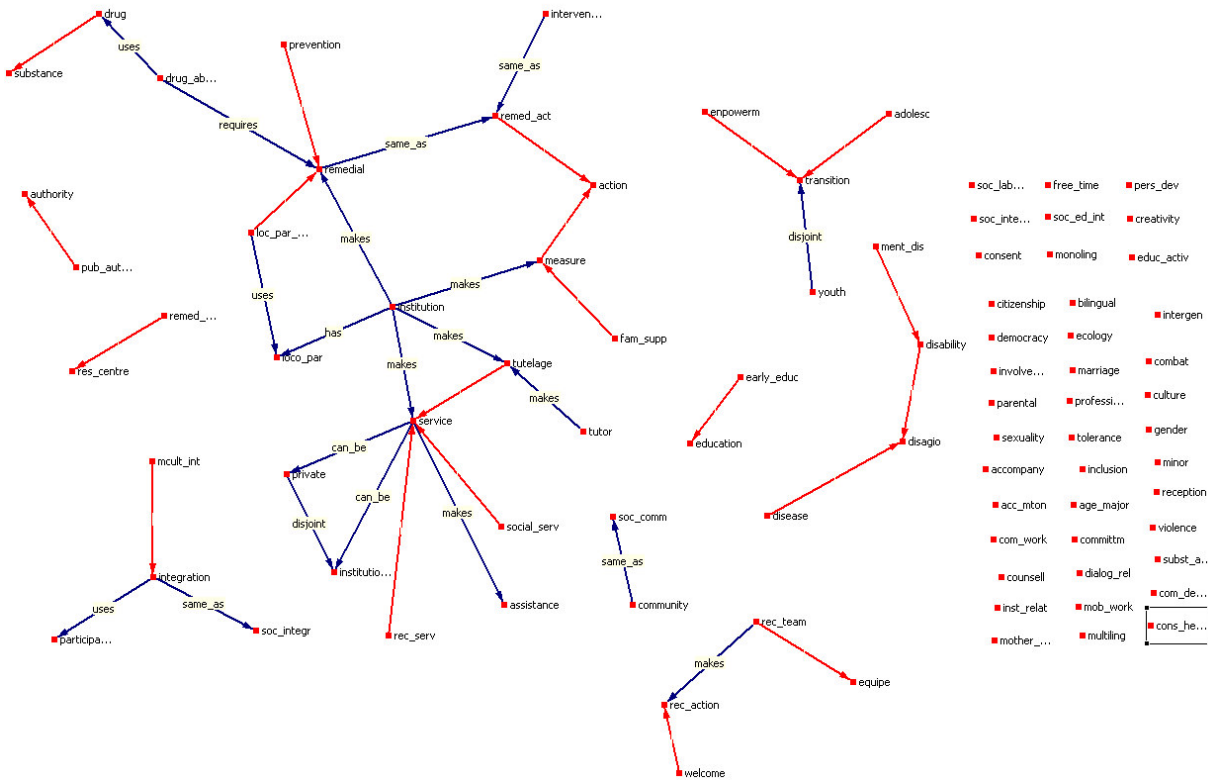

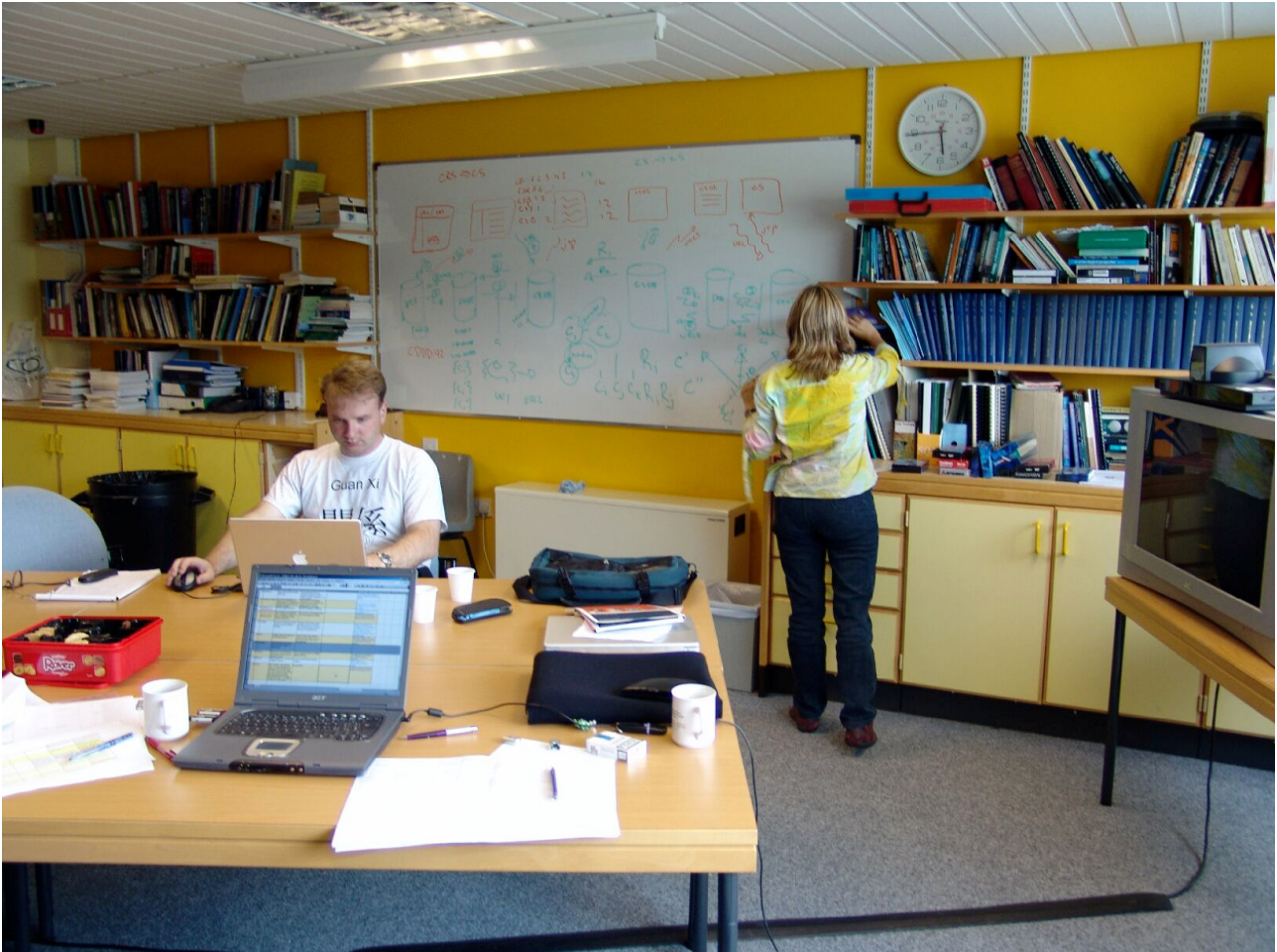
