

HOW TO GET THE MEETING POINT

Young Words Happening

Torino, 22nd -24th September 2005

Arrival date: 21st of September

Departure date: 25th of September

Meeting point if you are coming by train, by bus, or by plane:

(if you are coming by car, please follow the information below to reach directly the campground)

Train station: “Torino Porta Nuova”

The meeting point is the main hall of the train station, where you will find some volunteers wearing Young Words Happening T-shirts and waiting for you.

If you are coming by train:

Torino Porta Nuova is the main train station of Torino. All trains travelling to Torino (except the ones coming from Paris and Lyon) arrive at Torino Porta Nuova station.

If you are coming by bus:

Busses coming from abroad arrive at bus terminal.

Bus Terminal Address: Corso Vittorio Emanuele II at the corner with Corso Castelfidardo.

To go to the meeting point:

You should walk towards Corso Vittorio Emanuele II (it's the avenue you have in front of you) and then go to the bus stop “Inghilterra”. You should get on bus n. 68 (direction Casale Cap.) and get off after 5 stops.

You are in front of the Porta Nuova train station.

Bus ticket: you have to buy your ticket before getting on the bus. You can buy tickets in sigarette shops (“tabaccherie”) or in newspaper kiosks (“giornalai”). The cost of the ticket is Euro 0.90 cents.

If you are coming by plane:

- **If you are arriving at international Airport “Torino Caselle”:**

A bus will drive you directly to the train station Torino Porta Nuova.

Departure Location at the airport:

Arrivals level, just in front of exit.

Timetable:

every 30 minutes from 06:30 to 09:00

every 45 minutes from 09:00 to 17:15

every 30 minutes from 17:15 to 22:45

every 45 minutes from 22:45 to 23:30

Tickets:

News-stand (Departures lounge); tourist bureau, ticket office, ticket machines (Arrivals level); and aboard (+ Euro 0.50 extra-charge)

Ticket cost: 5.00 Euro

- If you are arriving at international Airport “Milano Malpensa”:
You should get a shuttle bus to train station “Milano Centrale”. The cheapest bus to Milano is the “Malpensa Shuttle”. You can take Malpensa Shuttle just in front of exit n. 5 (Terminal 1) at the Arrivals floor or in Terminal 2, at the Arrivals, in front of the exit.

You can purchase your Malpensa Shuttle ticket by the offices located nearby each main bus stop:

Malpensa – Terminal 1

Airport 2000 - Arrivals between exits 5 and 6

Travelex - Arrivals A-B

Malpensa – Terminal 2

Airpullman - Arrivals in front of the exit

Ticket cost: 5.00 Euro

Once you are in Milano you can get the first train to Torino Porta Nuova (it takes about 2 hours to get to Torino)

Intercity trains and Eurostars are more expensive. Interregionali and Direct trains are cheaper.

- If you are arriving at international airport “Orio al Serio”

In front of the arrivals, you can get a shuttle bus to Milano Centrale.

You can buy tickets on the bus.

Ticket costs are about: 6.00-6.70 Euro.

Once you are in Milano you can get the first train to Torino Porta Nuova (it takes about 2 hours to get to Torino)

Intercity trains and Eurostars are more expensive. Interregionali and Direct trains are cheaper.

- If you are arriving at international airport “Milano Linate”:

You should get the shuttle bus to train station Milano Centrale.

You can buy tickets on the bus.

Ticket cost: 2,50 Euro

Once you are in Milano you can get the first train to Torino Porta Nuova (it takes about 2 hours to get to Torino)

Intercity trains and Eurostars are more expensive. Interregionali and Direct trains are cheaper.

Meeting Point if you are coming by car: Villa Rey Campground

If you are coming to Torino by car:

If you are travelling on the Torino-Milano motorway A4/E64:

- Exit towards Abbadia di Stura, Chivasso, Autoporto Pescarito
- Get “strada statale Padana superiore m. 11”
- Get the exit towards Torino, Abbadia di Stura, Autoporto Pescarito
- Turn left in “Strada Vic. Della Cerbroza” and drive on for about 300 m.
- Turn right in “Strada di Settimo”
- Go along “Strada di Settimo” for about 2 km. Before crossing the bridge that you will find in front of you on “Strada di Settimo”, turn left along “Lungo Stura Lazio” and go ahead for about 2.5 km.
- Go along “Via Tommasio Agudio” for about 1 km
- Turn left in “Piazza Alberto Pasini”
- Turn right in “Corso Casale”
- Go along “Corso Casale” for about 2 km
- Turn left in “Corso Giuseppe Gabetti”. Go along for about 400 m and then continue on “Piazza Hermada”
- Turn left in “Strada Comunale Val San Martino” and go ahead for about 300 m
- Turn left in “Strada Val San Martino Superiore” and continue till you will get to number 27
- On your left you will see the Villa Rey Campground.

If you are travelling on the Torino-Piacenza motorway A21/E70

- After paying the motorway fare in Villanova D'Asti, continue on A21 for about 500 m and get the exit towards Chieri
- Turn right in "Strada Statale 10" to Chieri
- Continue on "Strada Statale 10" for about 21 km
- Once you are in Torino turn left in "Corso Casale"
- Go along "Corso Casale" for about 2.5 km
- Turn left in "Corso Giuseppe Gabetti". Go along for about 400 m and then continue on "Piazza Hermada"
- Turn left in "Strada Comunale Val San Martino" and go ahead for about 300 m
- Turn left in "Strada Val San Martino Superiore" and continue till you will get to number 27
- On your left you will see the Villa Rey Campground.

If you are travelling on the Torino-Aosta motorway A5/E25/E612

- Get the exit towards Torino, Corso Giulio Cesare, Corso Vercelli, Chivasso
- Get A55 for about 1.3 km
- Follow towards Abbadia di Stura, Chivasso on the "Strada Statale Padana Superiore /SS11
- Get the exit towards Torino, Abbadia di Stura, Autoporto Pescarito
- Turn left in "Strada Vic. Della Cerbroza" and drive on for about 300 m.
- Turn right in "Strada di Settimo"
- Go along "Strada di Settimo" for about 2 km. Before crossing the bridge that you will find in front of you on "Strada di Settimo", turn left along "Lungo Stura Lazio" and go ahead for about 2.5 km.
- Go along "Via Tommasio Agudio" for about 1 km
- Turn left in "Piazza Alberto Pasini"
